

Ken Wood Scholarship Fund

Application



MIC is a charity with a Scholarship Fund that is named in honour of Brett Wood's Father who gave him the passion for community service and volunteering. Ken Wood was an active member of Rotary throughout his working years and volunteered every Saturday morning to make toys for disadvantaged children.

One purpose of this Fund is equity by making education at the College available to all who wish to come including students who would not otherwise be able to afford the tuition fees and/or expenses. Students who may not be able to attend due to financial constraints can be assessed through an application process to the charity.

Scholarships may be available only to assist students with tuition fees and/or expenses at the College. No full scholarships are available from the Scholarship Fund but partial scholarships may be awarded each year.

Applications are on an annual basis and students who are successful in one year must still reapply for support each subsequent year.

Student Eligibility Criteria

An eligible Ken Wood Scholarship Fund Applicant:

- Is an Australian citizen or permanent resident of Australia
- Is a student attending or intending to attend the College
- Intends to undertake and complete their Queensland Certificate of Education or Statement of Attainment during their school enrolment and have the ability and the school's confidence of fully completing this by Year 12 Graduation.
- Is between the ages of 15 and 19
- Participates in school activities which enhance their music industry aspirations
- Demonstrates willingness to actively participate in the life of the school and be a worthy role model for other students

The amount of support for students through the Ken Wood Scholarship Fund is calculated as a percentage of the balance of tuition fees once all other grants/funds have been offset against costs involved to attend Music Industry College (eg) Commonwealth Supplement, QATSIF Scholarship Grants etc

Applications will be assessed on an individual basis through the Charity Sub-Committee of the Board and recommendations by this Committee will be final
